

Before working on your TANGO-SPR® riflescope always ensure that the firearm is unloaded with the safety on.


#### Mounting the riflescope

Choose rings and bases that correspond to your firearms action and the diameter of your riflescope's maintube. In order to maintain a comfortable cheek weld always mount your riflescope with the lowest possible ring height. Make sure that there is no interference with any of the moving parts of your firearm.

#### Set proper eye relief

Slightly loosen the riflescope rings and position the riflescope as far forward as it will mount. For adjustable power riflescopes select the highest possible power. Mount the rifle in a comfortable and repeatable, natural position. Adjust the position of the riflescope backwards until you have maximum field of view in your riflescope.

Ensure that the vertical crosshair of the riflescope matches the vertical centerline of your rifle and tighten the rings and bases to the correct torque


#### OPERATION

#### INSTALLING THE BATTERY

Some TANGO-SPR™ riflescopes are equipped with illuminated reticles and require a CR2032 Battery. To install the battery:


- 1. Use a cartridge case or coin to turn the battery port cover counterclockwise and remove it from the battery port.
- 2. Place the CR2032 battery into the battery port with the plus side (+) facing outward.
- 3. Reinstall the battery port cover by rotating the cap in the clockwise (CW) direction to 10 in-lbs.

Note – failure to properly torque the battery cap clockwise (CW) direction to 10 in-lbs could lead to ingestion hazard of coin battery, intermittent LED illumination or allow moisture into the battery compartment.



#### ILLUMINATION BRIGHTNESS LEVEL

- Rotate illumination power selector ring to select the illumination brightness level that best suits your conditions.
- Brightness level settings alternate between on and off locations.
- Numerical values indicate active illumination settings.
- Higher values indicate brighter illumination.






#### SIGHT ADJUSTMENTS

The riflescope will come optically centered. This should get you close to your rifles zero out of the box

#### Focusing the reticle with the diopter

Aim the riflescope at a light object to maximize the contrast of the reticle.

Turn the diopter until the reticle comes into focus.



#### **Adjusting Power**

TANGO-SPR<sup>®</sup> riflescopes are variable power. In order to increase the power setting rotate the power selector ring clockwise. Turn the power selector ring until the image is magnified to the desired range.

#### Bore sighting

If you are installing the riflescope from other than its factory settings it is best to bore site your riflescope. This will give you a coarse zero and will require further adjustments.

With the rifle in a firm rest, remove the bolt from your rifles action (with AR style rifles remove the rifles upper from its lower assembly and remove the bolt carrier). Look through the rifles barrel from the rear of the rifle and aim it so that your target is centered. Without moving the position of the barrel, use the elevation and windage adjustments of your riflescopes reticle so that it is also in the center of the target.

#### Point of Impact (POI) corrections

POI corrections should be done using the center of a three shot group. If you are not able to get a consistent three shot group then you will need to trouble shoot your rifle further.

If your POI is located to the left of your point of aim (POA) then you need to adjust the windage to the right. The value of each click is marked on your riflescope. To move your POI to the right you will need to turn the windage turret counter-clockwise. To move your POI left turn the windage turret clockwise.

If your POI is located below your POA then you need to adjust your elevation up. The value of each click is marked on your riflescope. To move your POI up you will need to turn the elevation turret counterclockwise. To move your POI down turn the elevation turret clockwise.

The goal of these adjustments is for your point of impact to match up with your point of aim. You will need to make windage or elevation adjustments in order to accomplish this.

#### Re-setting your zero - TANGO-SPR™

To reset the zero on your TANGO-SPR rifle scope, loosen the 2.5mm hex screw on the adjustment dial and rotate the dial to zero. Once you are back to zero, tighten the 2.5mm hex screw. Replace the dial cap.




#### **RESETTING THE ELEVATION DIAL**


Before resetting the zero of the elevation dial, see section 7.5.3 and adjust the POI elevation so that it is located where you want it in relation to your POA.

To reset the zero:

- 1. Use a cartridge case or a coin to unscrew elevation dial screw counterclockwise and remove it.
- 2. Lift elevation dial off the hub.




- 3. Use 0.05 in. hex wrench to turn three zero stop dial set screws (1) counterclockwise until loose.
- 4. Turn zero stop dial clockwise until it stops.
- 5. Use 0.05 in. hex wrench to turn three zero stop dial set screws clockwise until finger tight.
- 6. Align the  $\mathbf{0}$  on elevation dial with zero indicator line on the elevation turret.
- 7. Use a cartridge case or a coin to turn elevation dial screw clockwise into turret until finger tight.
- 8. Once your POI elevation is located where you want it in relation to your POA, push elevation dial down to lock.






#### SFP BDC1 RETICLE SUBTENSIONS

#### MAINTENANCE

Your SIG SAUER riflescope requires very low maintenance.

- If your riflescope came with turret caps make sure that they are installed when you are not making windage or elevation adjustments.
- Keep your lenses clear by using a soft cloth or lens pen. The best way to maintain image quality is by keeping your lenses clear of dirt and dust that cause scratches.

#### TROUBLESHOOTING

#### POI changes between groups

- Check that all of your mounts are tightened to the correct torque spec
- Check/Clean your rifle
- Check for variations in ammunition
